
AP Spanish Language & Culture - Class Preparation

- Begin to make a habit of reading and listening to Spanish on a regular basis by reading or watching the news in Spanish, listening to podcasts, watching Spanish TV, and other practice found above.
- Brush up on your vocabulary, focusing on filling the gaps for topics that you don't typically talk about from the AP Themes & Contexts.
- In lieu of a Summer Assignment that is submitted for a grade, you may submit a **reflection** of what you did over the summer to maintain your Spanish skills. The reflection needs to be **one page**, **12 pt. font**, **single-spaced**, **written completely in Spanish**, and it must include a variety of ways that you practiced the language (in other words, include specific titles of readings, films, series, apps, etc). You must also include a variety of domains of practice (listening, reading, writing, speaking, culture, etc.). If you complete this thoroughly, you will earn a *cupón de prueba* that you can redeem to drop the lowest two¹ scores of your multiple choice assessments during the semester of Fall 2020.
 - Reflection DUE: August 28, 2020. (No late reflections will be accepted.)



¹ Your *cupón de prueba* may only drop one multiple choice assessment if you don't do a thorough and complete job on the reflection.
