- b. Brandon Righetti-Marweg Physics teacher 2nd year introduces himself.
- c. Randall Soliz- World Languages Spanish teacher, been at NHS since 2011. Was Department Chair for many years. Mr. Soliz took a leave of absence for 2 years 17-19, and is happy to be back at NHS.
- d. Absent- Secretary Riley Hovey, Zach Lee (MSA student rep), Jayden Korinzer Andersen (student rep), Cinthia Angelicola (Liasion), and Caroline Purtell (classified rep).
- e. Denise McIntyre parent on SSC.
- 2. Athletics report (Denise McIntyre Head Varsity swimming coach in spring and Girls water polo coach in fall 2021). Says athletics are struggling to get parents to help at home events and games. It's the lowest participation for parent volunteerism supporting their athletes she can remember. Sports just wrapped up fall 2021 season. Novato High has started aggressively in winter athletics with basketball, soccer and wrestling for Winter sports season. Students get in to games with sports boosters sticker to sporting events. Trying to encourage more and more kids to watch games in the winter season.
- 3. <u>Sports Boosters</u> (President- Denise McIntyre). Sports Boosters working with kids to get into events and get parent participation. - Counselor Report (Greg Fister for Oscar Galdamez- who was absent from zoom).
 - a. Counseling just completed course selection process. All counselors were in College and Career Readiness 9th graders or Rising Sophomores. We open the aeries portal for parents and students, and for one week, kids can handpick their electives with their parents or in their classrooms with their academic counselor.
 - b. After Christmas break, counselors will be focused on current juniors = Rising seniors. Board policy NUSD, counselors are to invite parents for an in-person junior meeting with the student. Counselors create a power point that they send to all parents and all kids per grade level, so they can see and choose from our Academic Planning guide (course catalog), and it's on our homepage for Novato High under Quick Links right under the main home page slider photos.
