Why Photography?

- Understand the historical, cultural, and theory of photography and how it relates to modern society.
- Make informed choices about composition.
- Demonstrate proper camera procedures and digital process techniques.
- Create original works of art of increasing complexity.
- Understand and use steps in the conceptualization process.
- Develop knowledge of various career path possibilities.

Photo 1, 2, 3, and AP Photo at Novato High School are year-long classes designed to extend an all-encompassing and thoughtful approach to photography. Starting in the fall, students are introduced to topics varying from the evolution of photography and the operation of digital single-lens reflex cameras to the

basics of composition and presenting photographic work.

Students will work independently and in groups on assignments exploring fine art, documentary, and commercial photography genres while creating images showing their understanding of art and social movements throughout the medium's 180-year history.

During both semesters, students will engage with philosophies and theories related to photography, focusing on concept building, making connections using historical knowledge of the medium, descriptive writing, and discussions intended to help explore students' creative processes and intentions. Critiques, peer reviews, and self-reflections will help students better articulate their intentions and hone their analytical skills.
